Our air conditioned saloon is a perfect place to chill out and watch a movie, read a book or magazine, or sit with your notebook computer and edit treasured moments of the dives.

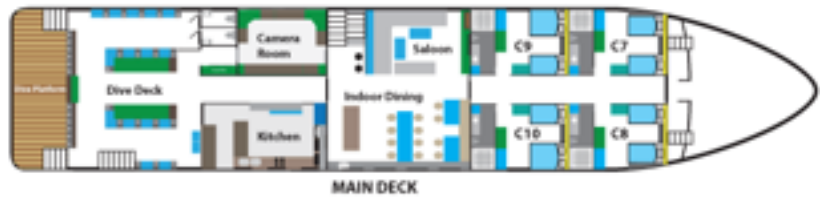
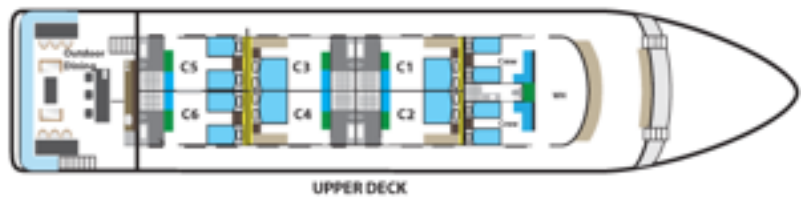

### ENRICHED AIR NITROX (EANx)

- ✦ Enriched Air Nitrox Fills and Courses are available on board to enhance diver safety.
- ✦ We recommend the use of Enriched Air for multi-day repetitive dive trips.
- ✦ The blending system on board is partial pressure. Therefore a dedicated cylinder is required.
- ✦ These are available in large and regular tank sizes and are allocated on a first come-first serve basis. Rebreather divers can recharge their 2l cylinders and gas blends can be tailored to the individuals' dive objective.

### Medical Assistance

Our management team is available 24 hours a day via our satellite communications to expedite tried and tested emergency evacuation plans to the nearest recompression chamber and/or modern hospital in [Bali](#)

An extensive first aid kit and plenty of emergency oxygen are always available. We have a dedicated room and bed for providing O2. Our Dive Staff and Boat Crew are trained in Primary (inc. CPR) & Secondary Care and are DAN O2 providers. Please bring any of your own medications that you may need.

Ensure you are in good condition for diving - prevention is always better than the cure. Remember to dive safely and to make sure DAN or other dive insurance is up to date.

### Communications

### Other Information

#### Child Policy

Children, Infants and Babies are all most welcome on board.

Diving child >10yrs pays full diver price.

Non-Diving child >12yrs pays full non-diver price (10% discount on diver price)

Non-Diving child >12yrs pays full non-diver price if sharing with one parent / guardian

Non-Diving child <12yrs pays 50% non-diver price if sharing with two parents/guardians

#### Single Supplement:

Guests travelling alone and unwilling to share with a stranger must pay full diver price + non-diver price. That is 90% extra of the total cabin cost.

#### Payment on board / Currency

Credit card; due to the very unreliable connections we are NO longer able to take ANY credit card payments on this trip. Please bring enough CASH to pay for any Trip Extras. Currencies accepted for payments; we will accept US Dollars, Euro, Singapore dollars, Indonesian Rupiah NOTE; Please ensure these bills are in good order; NOT worn or torn and unmarked or we are UNABLE to accept. ## FAQs & Other info

### Diving Considerations

#### Dive Times & Technical Divers

Total dive time is 1 hour including a mandatory safety stop. We can accommodate divers wishing to dive for longer; however, prior approval should be sought and will require the divers to kit up during the briefing. This is at the discretion of the Cruise Director.

Technical divers are also welcome onboard -we specialize in Technical Diving Charters in the South China Sea. Twin tank rental is available; fills attract an extra cost of US\$ 4. Oxygen fills are charged at us\$.25 / litre.

#### Camera Stations

We have dedicated rinse tanks, dive deck shelves and charging area for all camera setups. We have dedicated rinse tanks, dive deck shelves and charging area for all camera setups. Our dive crew is not permitted to use cameras whilst guiding. An underwater camera is available to rent.

#### Flying after Diving

Some guests have flight departures in the evening of the last day of the trip or early the next morning. We insist these divers plan a 24 hour surface interval and skip dives that fall inside this period.

#### Water temperatures & Exposure suits

Water temperature ranges from 22-26C in South Komodo to 26-28C in Central Komodo and up to 29C in Raja Ampat. We STRONGLY recommend a 5mm or 7mm long semi dry wetsuit. We have 3mm shorty, some 3mm long/ 5mm semi-dry but limited stock. Check for sizes, all equipment is subject to availability. We also recommend hood & rash vests for all Komodo trips.

#### Paper work & Documentation

At the start of the trip guests are required to sign a liability release form and provide evidence of their certification. Usually in the form of a certification card and logbook - if unavailable, and they have PADI certification - please verify by PADI Dive Check on-line.

### Blue Manta Trip Schedule;

**Departure; 3.30pm, 1<sup>st</sup> Day - Bajo Port, Labuan Bajo, Western Flores.** Or earlier if everyone arrives before and all Trip Preparations have been completed. Free transfer from Airport or local hotel to Bajo Port (15 mins) on Trip Departure day

**Return; 6am, Last Day - Bajo Port, Labuan Bajo, Western Flores.** After we give you a breakfast and after farewells take you to the Airport (LBJ) in time for Check-in & flight or local hotel.

**Last dive ends; 12pm, Penultimate Day,** followed by a walk on the wild side in search of Komodo dragons, then sail back to LBJ port for late evening. This allows for your minimum 18 hours surface interval/ No Fly Time (as

### Brief Itinerary Bali - Komodo; North & South 9day/ 8 nights (26 dives) (schedules are subjected to changes according to weather and sea condition)

**Day 1.** (0 dives) 13:00-15:00 hours in Benoa Harbour, Bali. 5.00pm, depart from Bali and sail over night to Moyo Island

**Day 2.** (4 dives) Moya and Satonda Island, overnight to Sangeang Island, off the north coast of Sumbawa.

**Day 3.** (4 dives) Sangeang and Banta Island.

**Day 4.** (4 dives) North Komodo; Castle Rock, Crystal Rock, Shot Gun, Gili Lawa. Pinnacles, drift dives full of action with hunting fish; jacks & sharks!

**Day 5.** (4 dives) North Komodo; Tatawa Besar & Kecil, Batu Bolong, Wainilu. Tons of Anthias, Napoleon wrasse, sharks, much night dive.

**Day 6.** (4 dives) South Komodo; Nusa Kode; Cannibal Rock, Yellow Wall, Torpedo Alley, Crinoid Crack. Macro; nudibranchs, octopus, frogfish, pigmy seahorses, & more.

**Day 7.** (4 dives) South Komodo, Padar Island; one of our favourite regions in the park with some stunning and diverse dive sites such as 3 Sisters and Pillarsteen.

**Day 8.** (2 dives) South Komodo; Manta Alley or Makassar Reef to fly with mantas. This is followed by a walk on the wide side in search of Komodo Dragons, and trekking on one of the local Islands, then back on board to wash gear relax as we sail towards Labuan Bajo, where you spend last night on Blue Manta in Bajo Port.

**Day 9.** (0 dives) 6am; check out after breakfast, farewells, and transfer to airport in time for Check-in & flight. Take your pre-booked flight from Labuan Bajo to Bali.

**Day 2-3.** (4 dives x2 days) diving around Banda Island; Pulau Ai, Batu Kapal, Karang Hatta, Pulau Keraka, Gunung Api, etc

**Day 4-9.** (4 dives x6 days) Ring of Fire, South Banda Forgotten Islands

**Day 10.** (2 dives) near Saumlaki

**Day 2.** (4 dives) Nudi Rock, Tank Rock, Whale Rock, & night dive

**Day 3.** (3 dives) Misool; Boo Corner, The Window, Magic Mountain, sail overnight North

**Day 4.** (4 dives) Yanggefo Island; Mayhem Ridge, Citrus ridge, Deep rock, & night dive

**Day 5.** (4 dives) Mansuar Corner, Manta Sandy, Cape Kri, & night dive
